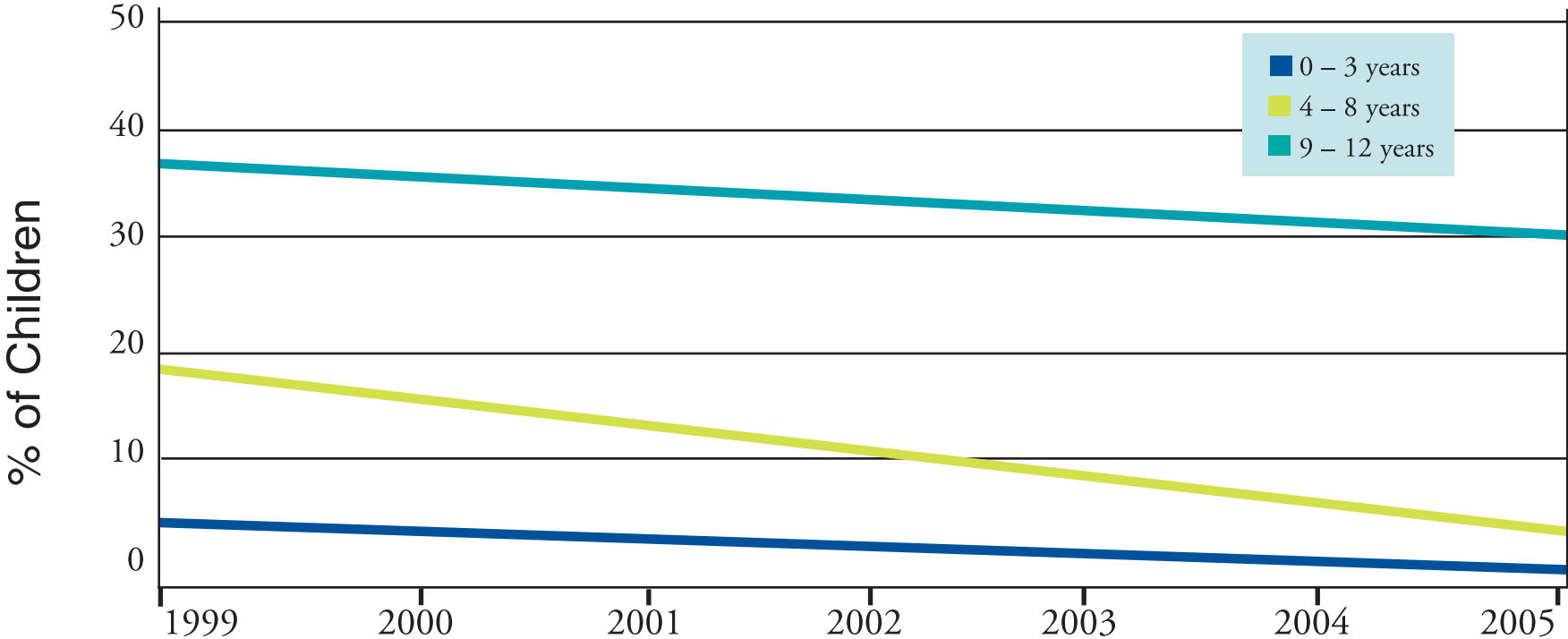


Front-Row Seating by Age Group



The vast majority of children who are younger than 4 years old sit in the rear seat; this has remained constant for the duration of the PCPS study. There has been a significant decrease in front-row seating among 4- to 8-year-olds. Nearly one-third of children aged 9 to 12 years (who should be restrained in the rear seat, according to current recommendations) sit in the front seat.
